Building Code/ Inspector Status

Carleen said that the attempt by the Select Board to solve the building inspector problem had come to a dead-end. All towns in NH are now required to have a building inspector. Two suggested solutions were:

- (1) Find a few leading builders who could share the task,
- (2) Find a respected builder ready to retire from active building to spend full time as an inspector for several local towns.

Carleen will ask Jeff Woodward how Lincoln handles the problem.

Jack will ask Sally how many building permits are open in Franconia. (Only three for this summer, more like 14 in recent other summers.)

Jack will talk with some local builders about the “share the load” possibilities.

Littleton Home Show Status

Bob Tortorice reported that the Littleton Chamber of Commerce would welcome our participation in the Littleton Home Show next Spring. It was recognized at the meeting that providing an appropriate shelter (tent) might be a problem.

LG Energy Information Meeting Status and Plan
